Minutes

1. Call to order
 - a. Called to Order at 7:00pm
2. Additions to the agenda
 - a. Juneteenth Holiday
 - i. Thomas Galinat spoke about Juneteenth as a new Federal Holiday. There was discussion about considering the holiday. No action taken.
 - b. Dave Stauffer spoke about updates to the roller barn, cemetery mowing and tree maintenance, and wild parsnip in East Peacham.
3. Highway Department update
 - a. Jeremy Withers said paving is completed in East Peacham and the Village. The crew has to do the shoulders still. Class 4 grading and Maple Tree Lane intersection are still priorities.
 - b. Withers said he is trying to fulfill the State equipment grant before the end of the month.
4. Wild Chervil, Road Side Mowing
 - a. Alfred Dedam spoke about how to prevent the spread of this invasive. Discussion involved different road side mowing techniques and adopting a policy on preventing the spread. No action taken.
5. Town Clerk/Treasurer update
 - a. Thomas Galinat spoke about receiving the warning and ballots for the August primary. Galinat spoke about digitizing records for 4 projects, scanning selectboard minutes to make them searchable, Town records to make them searchable, make the entire land record index available online, and bring current land records online. Galinat requested the use of restoration land records fund for this purpose. **Richard Browne moved to allow up to \$2500 from the restoration land records be used this project, seconded by Alfred Dedam, all in favor, so moved.**

7. Review and approve bills
 - a. **Richard Browne moved to approve the warrants as presented, seconded by Alfred Dedam, all in favor, so moved.**

 - a. Richard Browne spoke about a phone call he had regarding Town Meeting with Susan Clark. The board is planning on adding this to a future agenda for discussion in August.
